A minor is not required for this degree program.

All Project Based Coursework (ARTS 1313, 1314, 1315, 2313, 1316, & 1319) will be subject to a Transfer Portfolio Requirement to fully transfer. The BFA Portfolio Review is the Department of Art's process of review and evaluation before admitting students into any of the department's Bachelor of Fine Arts programs.

Students who wish to pursue a BFA in Graphic Design, Studio Art, Animation, or Photography must pass the department's BFA Portfolio Review.

The semester after completion of the Art Foundation courses, BFA majors are required to participate in the BFA Portfolio Review.
